Hurdles Selection Procedure

Danebank does not offer competition hurdles at the annual Senior School Athletics Carnival due to safety concerns for participants.

The following procedure will be adopted from 2019 to select hurdlers for the IGSSA Athletics Carnival.

1. A procedural document will be generated and distributed to all potential hurdlers prior to the Danebank Athletics Carnival.
2. The date and location of the Twilight Meet, at which the hurdles trial will be run, will be indicated. The document will identify those staff members attending as time-keepers as well as the staff member overseeing team selection for IGSSA Athletics.
3. The document will indicate the date by which any prospective hurdlers will have to nominate themselves, in writing, to the relevant sport staff member.
4. Danebank staff will time the trial event. These times will be final and selection will be based on these times.
5. If students do not compete at the trial, they will forfeit the opportunity to compete in the hurdles at IGSSA in that year. Selection or failure to gain selection will have no bearing on selection in further years.
6. On the Monday following the hurdles trial, the students and their parents will be notified of the athletes and reserves selected for each age group.
7. As for all students who gain selection for the IGSSA Athletics carnival, the decision of the staff member responsible will be final.

High Jump Selection Procedure

Danebank does not offer competition High Jump at the annual Senior School Athletics Carnival due to safety concerns for participants.

The following procedure will be adopted from 2019 to select High Jumpers for the IGSSA Athletics Carnival.

1. A procedural document will be generated and distributed to all potential High Jumpers prior to the Danebank Athletics Carnival.
2. The date and location of the Twilight Meet, at which the High Jump trial will be run, will be indicated. The document will identify those staff members attending as time-keepers as well as the staff member overseeing team selection for IGSSA Athletics.
3. The document will indicate the date by which any prospective High Jumpers will have to nominate themselves, in writing, to the relevant sport staff member.
4. Danebank staff will judge the trial event. These measurements will be final and selection will be based on these results.
5. If students do not compete at the trial, they will forfeit the opportunity to compete in the High Jump at IGSSA in that year. Selection or failure to gain selection will have no bearing on selection in further years.
6. On the Monday following the High Jump trial, the students and their parents will be notified of the athletes and reserves selected for each age group.
7. As for all students who gain selection for the IGSSA Athletics carnival, the decision of the staff member responsible will be final.

Cross Country Selection Procedure

The following procedure will be adopted from 2019 for selection to the IGSSA Cross Country Carnival.

1. Students wishing to be selected for the Cross Country team must have participated in at least one Danebank sport cross country lesson.
2. Danebank staff will oversee the sport lessons. Those students who place in the top eight for each age group will be automatically selected. These results will be final and selection will be based on these times.
3. If students do not participate in the school carnival, they will forfeit the opportunity to compete at IGSSA in that year. Selection or failure to gain selection will have no bearing on selection in further years.
4. Weeks following the school cross country lessons, the students selected to represent the school at IGSSA will be notified for each age group.
5. As for all students who gain selection for the IGSSA Cross Country carnival, the decision of the staff member responsible will be final.

Athletics and Swimming Selection Procedure

The following procedure will be adopted from 2019 for selection to the IGSSA Athletics and Swimming carnivals.

1. A procedural document will be generated each year and distributed to all potential athletes prior to the Danebank Athletics and Swimming carnivals respectively.
2. Students wishing to be selected in either the IGSSA Athletics or Swim Team must compete at the school carnivals. Staff overseeing team selection for IGSSA Athletics and Swimming will be identified in this document.
3. Danebank staff will be overseeing the respective carnivals. The results will be final and selection will be based on these results.
4. If students do not compete at the school carnivals, they will forfeit the opportunity to compete at IGSSA in that year. Selection or failure to gain selection will have no bearing on selection in further years.
5. Weeks following the school carnival, the students selected to represent Danebank at IGSSA will be notified for each discipline and age group.
6. As for all students who gain selection for the IGSSA Athletics and Swimming carnivals, the decision of the staff member responsible will be final.

For Athletics:

- Students who place first in the final for their discipline will be given automatic selection for

IGSSA. However, the only time this may change is when an athlete wins multiple events. A student can represent Danebank in a maximum of **four** individual events and **one** relay event. If a student who is selected in an event decides against competing in this event, the student who came second will be selected. These decisions will be made in conjunction with the staff member in charge of the carnival and finalised before team entries are due to IGSSA.

- For those IGSSA events not run at the Danebank carnival (High Jump and Hurdles), please refer to separate document.

For Swimming:

- Students who place first in the final for their discipline will be given automatic selection for IGSSA. However, the only time this may change is when an athlete wins multiple events. A student can represent Danebank in a maximum of **three** individual events and **one** relay event. If a student who is selected in an event decides against competing in this event, the student who came second will be selected. These decisions will be made in conjunction with the staff member in charge of the carnival and finalised before team entries are due to IGSSA.
